<p>Q1: <u>Tell</u> me how you would check that the <u>headlights & tail lights</u> are working?</p>	<p>A1: Turn on Ignition switch and Show symbol on dashboard Also <u>see reflection and then walk round vehicle if need too.</u></p>
<p>Q2: <u>Show</u> me how you would check that the <u>direction indicators</u> are working?</p>	<p>A2: Applying the indicators or <u>hazard warning</u> switch and check functioning of all indicators by <u>walk around the vehicle.</u></p>
<p>Q3: <u>Show</u> me how you would check that the <u>brake lights</u> are working on this car.</p>	<p>A3: Operate brake pedal, make use of <i>reflections in windows</i>, garage doors, etc, or <u>ask someone to help</u></p>
<p>Q4: <u>Show</u> me how you would check that the <u>horn</u> is working (off road only).</p>	<p>A4: Push the Horn switch</p>
<p>Q5: <u>Show</u> me how you switch your headlight from <u>dipped to main beam</u> and explain how you would know the main beam is on whilst inside the car</p>	<p>A5: Ignition on and switch on dipped head lights show main beam <u>Blue warning light on dashboard</u>, use when visibility is <u>less the 100 meter.</u></p>
<p>Q6: <u>Show</u> me how you would switch on the <u>rear fog light(s)</u> and explain when you would use it/them.</p>	<p>A6: Ignition on and turn on fog light switch. <u>Show yellow warning light on dashboard.</u> Use when visibility is <u>less than 100 meter</u></p>
<p>Q7: <u>Show</u> me how you would set the <u>demister controls</u> to clear all the windows effectively, this should include both front and rear screens</p>	<p>A7: Show demister switch for back window and front window and use when need to clear window from mists etc.</p>
<p>Q8: <u>Show</u> me how you would clean the windscreen using the <u>windscreen washer and wipers</u></p>	<p>A8: Operate control to wash and wipe windscreen (turn on ignition)</p>
<p>Q9: <u>Tell</u> me how you make sure your <u>head restraint</u> is correctly adjusted so it provides the best protection in the event of a crash</p>	<p>A9: The head restraint should be adjusted so the rigid part of the head restraint is at least as high as the eye or top of the ears.</p>
<p>Q10: <u>Tell</u> me how you would know if there was a problem with your <u>anti lock braking system</u></p>	<p>A10: Warning <u>ABS</u> light should show if there is a fault with the anti lock braking system</p>

<p>Q11: <u>Tell</u> me how you would check the <u>parking brake</u> (handbrake) for excessive wear, make sure you keep safe control of the vehicle</p>	<p>A11: Tell when applying handbrake it should <u>secures itself</u>, and it is <u>not too high up</u></p>
<p>Q12: <u>Tell</u> me how you would check that the <u>brakes</u> are working before starting a journey.</p>	<p>A12: Brakes <u>should not feel spongy or slack</u>. Brakes should be tested as you set off. <u>Vehicle should not pull to one side</u>.</p>
<p>Q13: <u>Tell</u> how you would check that the <u>power assisted steering</u> is working before starting a journey</p>	<p>A13: If the steering becomes <u>heavy the system may not be working properly</u>.</p>
<p>Q14: <u>Tell</u> me where you would find the <u>information</u> for the recommended <u>tyre pressures</u> for this car and how tyre pressures should be checked.</p>	<p>A14: Information in <u>Car hand book / Manuel</u>, and use <u>Reliable pressure gauge</u>, check and when tyres are cold, include spare tyre,</p>
<p>Q15: <u>Tell</u> me how you would check the <u>tyres</u> to ensure that they have <u>sufficient tread depth</u> and that their general condition is safe to use on the road.</p>	<p>A15: <u>No cuts and bulges, 1.6mm of tread depth across the central ¾</u> of the breadth of the tyre and around the entire outer circumference.</p>
<p>Q16: <u>Open</u> the bonnet, identify where you would check the <u>engine oil</u> level and tell me how you would check that the engine has sufficient oil.</p>	<p>A16: Identify dipstick / oil level indicator, describe check of oil level against the <u>high / low</u> markers.</p>
<p>Q17: <u>Open</u> the bonnet, identify where you would check the <u>engine coolant</u> level and tell me how you would check that the engine has the correct level</p>	<p>A17: Identify <u>high / low</u> level markings on header tank where fitted or radiator filler cap, and describe how to top up to correct level.</p>
<p>Q18: <u>Open</u> the bonnet, identify where the <u>brake fluid</u> reservoir is and tell me how you would check that you have a safe level of hydraulic brake fluid.</p>	<p>A18: Identify reservoir, check level against <u>high / low</u> markings.</p>
<p>Q19: <u>Open</u> bonnet and Identify where the <u>windscreen washer reservoir</u> is and tell me how you would check the windscreen washer level</p>	<p>A19: Identify reservoir and it should be filled to the top.</p>
